Official Contestant Rules & Regulations

- 1) Cooking shall be done on-site; contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, pots, heating, generators/power supply, tents, tables, cleanup, etc. Paper products, tasting cups and spoons to serve guests will be provided by committee. Contestants are permitted to set up one 10x10 tent per site. The committee will provide a marked area for each contestant team.
- 2) Prep work that does not involve cooking may be done prior to arrival. All cooking must be done on site. Each contestant must cook a minimum of one quart of competition chili prepared in one pot, which will be submitted for judging. Judging will be at 5:00 p.m. Teams should be prepared to serve 4 to 6 gallons to the public.
- 3) A representative of the committee will conduct a contestants' meeting thirty minutes prior to the official time of the cook-off (1:30), at which time final instructions will be given and questions answered. Chili must be ready at 4:30 p.m. Each contestant will be assigned a number by the Chief Judge, and be given an official 32-oz. Judging Cup. Contestants are responsible for verifying that the number on the bottom of the cup corresponds with the assigned contestant number. Contestants must deliver their full cup to the Judge's tent by the announced time for judging.
- 4) Judges will base their votes on: flavor, texture, consistency, blend of spices, aroma and color.
- 5) The decisions of the Chief Judge shall be final.
- 6) Awards will be given by the Chief Judge to the top 3 contestants.
